## Updates and Reminders

### Open House:

We will be hosting an Open House on Thursday, October 7<sup>th</sup> from 5:00-7:00 p.m. In order to make this a safe event, we are asking that our families adhere to the following schedule:

**5:00-5:50 p.m.:** Families with a last name that begins with A-K attend at this time. Adults must wear a mask in the building and sign in at one of the tables outside the school at the front entrance. We ask that you visit your children's classrooms and between 5:00-5:50 p.m. Being punctual will help with the number of adults in the building as well as the parking lot situation.

**6:00-6:50 p.m.:** Families with a last name that begins with L-Z attend at this time. Adults must wear a mask in the building and sign in at one of the tables outside the school at the front entrance. We will announce at 6:50 p.m. that Open House is ending so that everyone has time to exit the building on time.
