Healthy Schools Contest: In January, 2023, our school participated in the Northern Health "Healthy Schools" Contest. Students tracked healthy eating, participation in physical activity and reading minutes over a two-week period. 80% of our students participated in this healthy school challenge. We were notified this week that our school won the top prize of \$5000.00. We had discussed with the students that if we won the grand prize, we would donate \$2500.00 to the P.A.C. to assist with the cost of the surface for the kindergarten playground. This leaves \$2500.00 that we can use for other schoolwide activities. Classrooms have been asked to submit ideas for how we can use this win to provide some healthy choices for our students, particularly in the winter months. We will vote on ideas if there isn't consensus by classrooms. What a great contest to win!

Attendance: School attendance can greatly affect how a student does in school, both academically and socially/emotionally. Developing good attendance habits is crucial in elementary school for success throughout the school years. Missing 2 days/month may not sound like alot of time. However, in one school year that adds up to 12% of the school year. We have attached a poster of information on how attendance may affect your child's learning and feeling of success in school. Our attendance last year was impacting how students felt and how they performed academically. Children who do not have regular attendance, have gaps in their learning, which contributes to mental well-being, anxiety, missed assignments, less connection to peers and a feeling of not knowing what is going on in school. Below is a table of absences recorded throughout the last school year. Overall, 143/332 students in our school missed 20+ days last year. That is 43% of our student population!
