Letter grades in intermediate have been changed to match the proficiency scales in the primary years. The proficiency scale makes learning the focus rathern that than the comparison with others. It lets you know where your child is in their learning and what they need to work on. Along with the information provided by the proficiency scale, you will receive written comments to give you even more information about what your child can work on. The learning update will include student self-assessments of the Core competencies as well as goal setting in each term.

The Proficiency Scale will be used in learning updates and summaries of learning (previously known as report cards) starting in the 2023-2024 school year.
