The following **board positions** are available for a 1 year term:

<u>Vice Chair person:</u> Runs the meeting if the Chair is not in attendance.

Secretary: Takes meeting minutes, checks the email account.

<u>Treasurer:</u> Documents the financial transactions.

The time commitment for each position is usually only about 1-2 hours including meetings and other duties per month during the school year. If you're worried you don't have the skills necessary for a position, we will provide support and train as necessary.

If we can not fill our MMMCS PAC board positions we run the risk of dissolving.

If our PAC dissolves, all of the hard earned PAC money and assets would be distributed to other schools / DPAC in our school district. Our MMMCS students would be the ones missing out.

Here are some of the things our MMMCS PAC has done:

We host family movie nights and assist with the MMMCS Block Party. We have purchased: baseball gloves and equipment, bike safety day prizes, 2 water fountains, Ipads and cart, and student snow equipment (toboggans, shovels, and block makers). We helped fundraise for and coordinate the back playground installation. We assist with funding for the grade 6 graduation, and busing/referees for sports teams. We also bring up parental concerns with the school administrators.

We are currently working towards raising money to install a rubber surface at front playground to remove the wood chips. This is a big goal, but we are approximately 1/3 of the way to our goal.

The MMMCS PAC usually meets once a month during school months, and the meetings usually last about 45min – 1 hr. Even if you do not wish to take on a board position, we appreciate when parents come to the meetings (even if it's just to sit and listen). We are a welcoming group of parents, who would like to see more parents/guardians attend the meetings this year.
